FINANCIAL NEED BASED SCHOLARSHIPS

I. PATRICK DINEEN '85 MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Who Qualifies:	Incoming 9 th Graders to SCHS with outstanding academic records and demonstrated financial need.
Application Deadline:	March 15 th , 2024
Application Process:	Students must be formally accepted to Shrine Catholic High School and write a 300 word essay answering the following question, "Why would you be a value added member of the Shrine Catholic Community? Please explain and cite examples." Students must also submit TWO letters of recommendation. Families must complete the FACTS Grant and Aid application.
Maximum Amount:	Partial Tuition Scholarship based on Financial Need (renewable for each year that student attends SCHS).
Award Announcement:	April 30 th , 2024

SHRINE CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL DAD'S CLUB SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP

Who Qualifies:	Any Shrine Catholic High School student, grades 9-12 who exhibits exemplary service to the community may qualify for a service award. The scholarship is based on a student's ability to achieve his or her "personal best" through service to his/her community. Families must demonstrate financial need and complete the FACTS Grant and Aid Application.
Application Deadline:	February 15 th , 2024
Application Process:	Students must have one letter of recommendation submitted on their behalf.
Award Range:	\$1,500-\$3,000
Award Announcement:	March 31 st , 2024

DAVID MACKER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Who Qualifies:	Any Shrine Catholic High School students grades 9-12 is eligible. It is awarded to the student with traits that Mr. Macker modeled: leadership, motivation of fellow students, excellence in character, as well as genuine concern for the overall well-being of his/her peers. This scholarship is for a student demonstrating the ability to motivate and encourage fellow students to be reach their “personal best”, through leadership by example. Families must have demonstrated financial need and complete the FACTS Grant and Aid scholarship.
Application Deadline:	February 15 th , 2024
Application Process:	Students must have one letter of recommendation submitted on their behalf.
Award Range:	\$1,500-\$3,000
Award Announcement:	March 31 st , 2024

CONNIE KRAEMER LEVEL '61 MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Who Qualifies:	Incoming 9 th Grade students to Shrine Catholic High School and any returning students in Grades 10-12 with a demonstrated interest in journalism and a demonstrated financial need.
Application Process:	Students must submit a 250 word essay describing a favorite memory from their extracurricular involvement.
Application Deadline:	February 15 th , 2024
Maximum Amount:	\$5,000 (non-renewable)
Award Announcement:	March 31 st 2024

JAMES HARBOUR MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Who Qualifies:	Students in Grades 9-12 with a demonstrated interest in S.T.E.M. or engineering and demonstrated financial need.
Application Process:	Students must be formally accepted to Shrine Catholic High School and write a two-page essay discussing how studying and mastering the STEM academic challenges presented to you in high school will motivate you to become an innovative

and creative thinker ready to meet the 21st century challenges. Applicants must also submit one letter of recommendation. The applicant's family must be an active member of Shrine parish for 5 years with a giving record. Families must have a demonstrated financial need and complete the FACTS Grant and Aid application

Application Deadline: February 15th, 2024

Maximum Amount: \$2,500-\$5,000

Award Announcement: March 31st, 2024

LARRY MCNISH LEADERSHP SCHOLARSHIP

Who qualifies: Returning Shrine Catholic High School students in Grades 10-12 with demonstrated financial need, in good academic standing, and involved in extracurricular or volunteer activities.

Application Process: Students must submit an essay answering the questions outlined on the Shrine Schools Website under Scholarships. Parents must submit the Grant and Aid application through FACTS and also answer questions found on the Shrine Schools Website under Scholarships.

Application Deadline: April 1st, 2024

Maximum Amount: Varies depending on family need.

Award Announcement: To be announced.

KATHLEEN KALPIN COBLDICK '83 MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Who Qualifies: Students entering grades 9-12 who are involved in community service and have a demonstrated financial need.

Application Process: Students must submit a list of all clubs, volunteer activities and extracurricular activities that they are involved in and a 250-word essay write about an experience in which your service or leadership made a direct impact on your school, parish or other organization.

Application Deadline: February 15th, 2024

Maximum Amount: \$1,500

Award Announcement: March 31st, 2024

JUNE AND HENRY NAGEL SCHOLARSHIP

Who Qualifies: Students entering 9th grade at Shrine Catholic High School.

Application Process: Students must write an essay answering the following prompt: "Discuss how your desire for a good education, your spiritual values and your wanting to help others in service or volunteer activities make you a candidate to receive the June & Henry Nagel Endowed Scholarship. Applicants must submit one letter of recommendation from their parish priest or youth minister. Families must complete the FACTS Grant and Aid application.

Application Deadline: February 15th, 2024

Maximum Amount: \$1,000 (renewable for 4 years)

Award Announcement: March 31st, 2024

SCHOLARSHIPS NOT BASED ON FINANCIAL NEED

HALL OF FAME SCHOLARSHIP

Who qualifies:	New or returning Shrine Catholic High School students who participate in athletics.
Application Process:	Students must write a 250-500 word essay on the following prompt, "What has athletics taught you that will impact your life outside of the field/court?"
Application Deadline:	February 15 th , 2024
Maximum Amount:	\$1,500 (not renewable, but students are invited to reapply for subsequent years). Awarded to four students per year.
Award Announcement:	March 31 st , 2024

SENIOR CHALLENGE AWARD

Who qualifies:	Current 11 th grade students registered for Senior Year.
Application Process:	Students must write a 200-word essay answering one of the following questions: 1) Describe your proudest moment or achievement at Shrine. <i>OR</i> 2) What has been your favorite memory or experience during your time at Shrine?
Application Deadline:	April 15 th , 2024
Maximum Amount:	\$400-\$500
Award Announcement:	During Senior Convocation on May 23 rd , 2024

CONSTITUTIONAL STUDIES SCHOLARSHIP

Who Qualifies:	Sophomore or Junior students enrolled in Constitutional Studies course in the fall of 2023.
Application Process:	No application required.
Maximum Amount:	\$5,000 to the highest performing student in the class, \$1,000 for other high performing students.
Award Announcement:	May 2024
